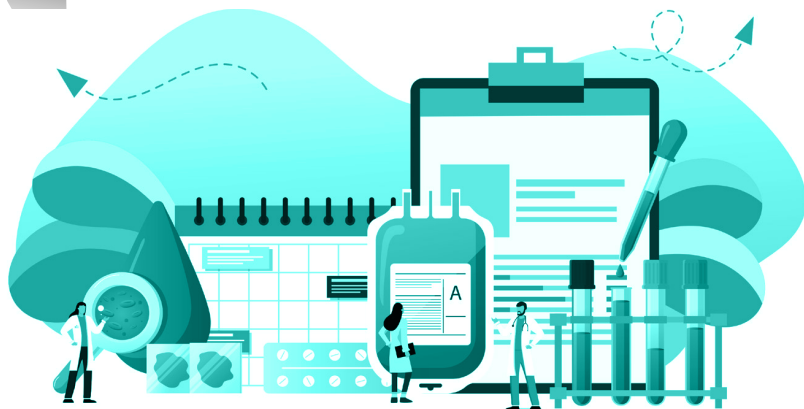




Amgen Innovation Award For Young Hematologist

Young hematologists or hematologists in training are invited to submit their project and apply for the AMGINY Award For Young Hematologist Innovation.

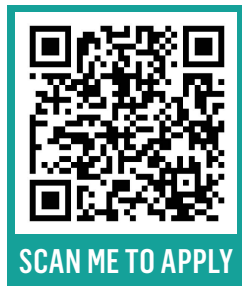
Terms and condition to apply are available on the BHS website. The deadline of submission is **Monday December 9th, 2024 (midnight CET)**.

The “AMGINY Award” jury will select only one (1) innovating project which will be awarded with 20,000 euros.

The award ceremony will take place during the 40th BHS General Annual Meeting, February 7-8, 2025.

We are looking forward to receiving outstanding projects that can change the natural history of hematological diseases.

Award Criteria

Who can apply?

- Be a member of the BHS and a natural person
- Young hematologists (<35 years) or hematologists in training who are MD and are within 10 MD graduation
- May not be an employee of the pharmaceutical industry

Which projects are eligible?

- Innovative projects dedicated to enhance patient care with blood disorders (e.g. screening, diagnosis, treatment decision-making, and follow-up) by leveraging advanced technologies
- Projects should be carried out in the hospital or outpatient setting (but with a link to the hospital)
- Projects utilising artificial intelligence (AI) or big data are of particular interest

Application requirements?

- Description of the project including costs and time frame (max. 3 pages)
- Description of the different project members and CV of the applicant
- A summary in abstract format with a maximum of 2500 characters (including spaces) for possible publication in the Belgian Journal of Hematology
