The “SAFYHR award” jury will select only one (1) innovating project which will be awarded with 15.000 euro. The award ceremony will take place during the **41st BHS General Annual Meeting, February 6-7, 2026**.

Award Criteria

Who can apply?

- Young hematologists or and pediatric hematologists in training who are MD and are within 10 years after MD graduation
- Young researchers (PhD student) with a hematologist as their promoter or co-promoter
- The topic of research is related to translational research within the field of hematology

Which projects are eligible?

Application requirements?

- Description of the research project including costs and timeframe (max. 2 pages)
- Letter of support by a promotor from the department where the research will be performed (max. 1 page)
- Motivational letter (max. 1 page)
- List of publications (if applicable)
- CV

Application forms are available on the BHS website <https://bhs.be/practice/safyhr-award> and must be submitted before December 8th 2025. Only submission through the online form is possible. Submissions sent by e-mail will not be considered.
